

COVID-19 Vaccine Update

Warren County Health Services Vaccine Clinic

Thursday, June 3 from 1:30 p.m. to 3 p.m. in Queensbury, offering the one-shot **Johnson & Johnson/ Janssen vaccine**.

The vaccination team is also continuing to work with businesses to establish **on-site COVID-19 vaccination clinics at workplaces**. If your business has staff who want to be vaccinated without having to leave their workplace, call **518-761-6580** and ask for Health Services Director Ginelle Jones.

Homebound vaccinations are continuing on an as-needed basis. Those seeking vaccination of homebound individuals can call Warren County Health Services at **518-761-6580**.

New York State mass vaccination site at Aviation Mall in Queensbury continues to offer walk-in availability of Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson/Janssen COVID vaccines. Those 12 and up can receive Pfizer vaccine, 18-and-up Johnson & Johnson vaccine. Appointments at the site can still be scheduled, and walk-ins will be allowed on a first come, first served basis at New York State vaccination sites between **8 a.m. and 6 p.m. 7 days a week**.

Several local pharmacies continue to have open COVID vaccine appointments today. Walmart pharmacies on Route 9 in Queensbury and Quaker Ridge Road in Queensbury were booking appointments this afternoon and the rest of the week, while Walgreens, CVS, Price Chopper/Market 32, Hannaford, Kinney Drugs, Stone's Pharmacy in Lake Luzerne and Rite Aid are also regularly getting allotments.

Did you know that?

- 58% of CWI's employees have said YES to the COVID-19 vaccine? Nearly 100% of them are fully vaccinated.
- 50/52 of CWI's residents are fully vaccinated.
- **40,006 Warren County residents** (62.3% of the county's population, 5th highest among counties in New York State) received their first vaccine doses as of June 1, and 35,598 have been fully vaccinated.
- **55.4% of Warren County residents** have completed a vaccination series (1st in the Capital Region), compared to the **state average of 45.9%**.
